The shaft crupper, belly-band, and cheeks of the bridle should be made on the same principle. The housings of the saddle and collar are better glued together when lined, instead of being pasted. The firmness of a set thus built will be beyond all comparison with the wide over-loading and flimsily made old pattern harness. All the stitching should be carefully rubbed down at the bottom side, and if the top is hammered it should be done very lightly, and only for the purpose of rounding the work off after wetting; if the mark of the face of the hammer is left it indicates hurried or careless workmanship. The hurried manner in which the shaft horse is sometimes forced down hill plainly indicates the necessity for a safe breech-band and hip straps....

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
